

Village of Petersburg Minutes
June 24th, 2021

The Petersburg Village Board met for a special meeting June 24th, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., notice was published and posted at the Village Office, Post Office, and Leifeld's. The board was given prior notice of the meeting. Chairman Stokes called the meeting to order and stated the Open Meetings Act was posted.

Trustees present were: Corey Stokes, Ashley Thieman, Tina Henn, Steve Werner, and Mitch Koch. Staff present: Sundae Provencher.

Verizon bill was presented for payment, due to it being due prior to the next board meeting.

Provencher informed the board of the American Rescue Plan Act. The board discussed whether or not to accept the funds from the Department of Treasury. The application whether or not the Village chooses to accept the funds is due July 2nd. Werner thought the Clerk should look into it further and see what kind of stipulations are involved in the program. The board was wondering if the Village had to prove they lost any income or if they had to pay the funds back. Provencher stated she didn't think so, however, there is a Zoom meeting about it on Monday so she would know more about it after that. Werner made a motion to proceed with the application for the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds through the American Rescue Plan Act pending what the Clerk learns through the Zoom meeting June 28th, seconded by Thieman. Roll call: Stokes-aye; Henn-aye; Koch-aye; Thieman-aye; Werner-aye; motion carried.

Stokes made a motion to go into closed session to discuss the school property, seconded by Thieman. Roll call: Stokes-aye; Henn-aye; Koch-aye; Thieman-aye; Werner-aye. Board entered closed session at 7:14p.m.

Stokes made a motion to come out of closed session at 8:23 p.m. seconded by Thieman. Roll call: Stokes-aye; Henn-aye; Koch-aye; Thieman-aye; Werner-aye, motion carried.

The board discussed requesting to be put on the School Board's Agenda in August to see what they are thinking about doing with the middle school property.

Provencher asked the board who would be representing Petersburg at the Planning Commission Meeting for the Annexation of Koch's III addition Monday, June 28th, 2021. Stokes and Koch plan to attend.

Werner made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Koch, Roll Call: Stokes-aye; Henn-aye; Thieman-aye; Koch-aye; Werner-aye, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
